Updated Classifications of the Bivalve Mollusc Production Areas in England and Wales for 2016-17

The Food Standards Agency wishes to notify you of the following update to the classifications of bivalve production areas:

DESIGNATED BIVALVE MOLLUSC PRODUCTION AREAS IN ENGLAND AND WALES

Correction to interim update of 27 October 2017

Lune: Wyre Estuary (*Mytilus* spp.) B066Y

This site should be listed as declassified **seasonal** class B note 7 (not declassified B note 7 as in the update issued on 27 October 2017).

This was an error but compliance at Wyre Estuary is 77.8% over the last year and 76% over the last 3 years so it does not comply with class B. The class B season is still evident, as over the class B season (in the last 3 years) the compliance is 91.7% so it can still be listed as declassified seasonal B.
