Professor Hugh Pennington studied medicine and obtained his PhD at St Thomas's Hospital Medical School, London. He spent ten years in Glasgow at the MRC Institute of Virology before being appointed Professor of Bacteriology at the University of Aberdeen (Emeritus 2003). A 2009 Desert Island Discs castaway, he blogs on microbiological topics for the London Review of Books. He chaired an Expert Group for the Secretary of State for Scotland into the 1996 Central Scotland E.coli O157 outbreak and chaired the Public Inquiry into the 2005 South Wales E.coli O157 outbreak. He is a Fellow of the Royal Society of Edinburgh and of the Academy of Medical Sciences.
