



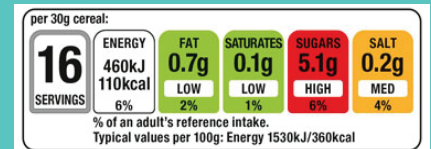
Food Information Regulation Update (FIR) Half Day Seminar

The Food Information Regulations 2014 Statutory Instrument has now been laid before UK Parliament, which puts in place the enforcement measures of the EU FIC (Food Information to Consumers). The new Regulations also consolidate existing general food and nutrition labelling Regulations in England. The Food Labelling Regulations 1996 are also amended by the new Regulations. They are amended on 15 August 2014 (the first coming into force date) to take account of certain transitional provisions that apply under EU FIC before the main provisions of EU FIC apply on 13th December 2014. The implications of this new SI will be discussed.
